Position Summary

This position will report to the District Quality Control Manager and is responsible for management and overseeing of the quality of the concrete products at 3-5 plants. May be required to supervise up to three Quality Control Technicians.

Requirements

- Proactive in SAFETY and works well in a team
- College degree in Concrete Management or related field is desired, minimal of High School degree/GED
- Knowledge of types of construction materials (aggregates/concrete/add mixtures)
- Desired 5 years of experience in Concrete industry, min of 1-2 years aggregates/concrete experience
- Must be able to read and understand technical manuals and perform tests as required
- Develop and maintain up to date knowledge of all governing specifications for concrete products, A.S.T.M. and D.O.T.D..
- Maintain current knowledge of relevant concrete ingredients and their application (aggregates, cements, admixtures, etc.)
- Spot Check for proper design, scale weights, water demand, slump, entrained air, yield, unit weight, materials mix and any other required specifications at field locations and at the plants.
- Perform physical tests of the concrete at the plant and in the field as required, make appropriated adjustments to in process concrete with independent decision making authority.
- Observe record activities and coordinate with outside testing agencies and contractors as they relate to the fresh and finished product.
- Develop and maintain excellent working relationships with customers, government agencies, inspectors, sales, distribution, production, in order to adjust the product to resolve specific customer requirements.
- Maintain written daily log of activities and observations and reports as required. Note misuse of products by driver or customer and take immediate measures to correct same. Report field issues to appropriate management.
- Input statistical data into the computer on a regular basis.
- Generate ideas to improve quality and increased margins in all operations.

- Investigate complaints regarding product quality or quantity and prepare documentation in response to same. Give opinions when appropriate to customers concerning field issues.
- May temporarily lead small team on larger placements or placements in or out of the district to support the District or Division.
- Assists in developing and implementing training program for technical service reps.

Education and Experience

- Concrete Management Degree, Engineering Degree or Industry related Bachelor's degree.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills are required
- Computer literacy is required. Desired Competency in COMMAND batching system.
- ACI Level 1 Field Testing Certified, ACT Strength Testing Technician, ACI Aggregate Testing Technician 1 strongly desired
- Strong Customer Service skills in resolving concerns of the customer. Climb 8 foot plus ladder a minimum of 20 times a day. Operate Company vehicle for minimum of 8 hours per day including entering and exiting the vehicle frequently.

Working Conditions

Must work outside in all weather conditions, heat, cold, dust and rain a minimum of 8 hours per day, six days a week and some Sundays. May also work in laboratory, conditions as needed. Noise level reaches a maximum of 100 db for up to 3 minutes 10 times a day and average 80 db for a minimum of 8 hours per day. Will work with Portland cement, concrete, gravel, sand, fly ash and associated add mixtures.
